For over 50 years, the Navy Marine Mammal Program has helped to protect our men and women at sea. Navy dolphins and sea lions travel globally to help recover lost objects in the sea and to help with humanitarian de-mining missions. Housed in San Diego Bay, Navy dolphins and sea lions work alongside their human partners in the open ocean every day.

Navy marine mammal facilities are not open to the general public, and are not designed for public exhibits. Floating walkways are unstable platforms. Consequently, only visitors that are physically fit and capable of walking independently are allowed on floating walkways.
