

Our Program for Tuesday, March 8th, 2022 Captain John C. Witte, USN Deputy for Training, Submarine Squadron Eleven Interim Commanding Officer, USS CONNECTICUT (SSN 22)

The Luncheon and Professional Forum will Host Captain John Witte as he discusses the Surfaced Transit of the Pacific on the USS CONNECTICUT, damaged following a submerged grounding.

Captain John C. Witte, USN

A native of Omaha, Nebraska, Captain Witte graduated from Iowa State University in 2000 with a Bachelor of Science in Food Science. He also completed a Master of Engineering Management from Old Dominion University and a Master of Science in Joint Campaign Planning and Strategy from the Joint Forces Staff College.

His Division Officer tour was onboard USS ALBUQUERQUE (SSN 706) in Groton, CT, where he completed an Engineered Refueling Overhaul and Arabian Gulf deployment. The ship earned the COMSUBRON TWO Battle Efficiency "E" Award in 2004. CAPT Witte's Department Head tour was onboard USS MICHI-GAN (SSGN 727) (GOLD) in Bangor, WA, where he served as the Engineer Officer. MICHIGAN completed two Western Pacific Deployments and earned the COMSUBRON NINETEEN Engineering "E" Award in 2009. His next sea tour was as Executive Officer (and Plank Owner) onboard USS MINNESOTA (SSN 783) in Norfolk, VA, where he led the crew through initial construction, sea trials and commissioning.

He was the Commanding Officer of USS ANNAPOLIS (SSN 760) in San Diego, CA. During his time in command, the ship completed two Western Pacific Deployments and was awarded the COMSUBRON ELEVEN Battle Efficiency "E" Award in 2020. He also served as the interim Commanding Officer of USS CONNECTICUT (SSN 22) for her transit home after the ship ran aground in 2021.

His shore tours include serving as the Naval Special Warfare Officer at COMSUBRON ONE in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, and the U.S. Fleet Forces Command Nuclear Propulsion Examining Board in Norfolk, Virginia. Following his Executive Officer tour, CAPT Witte attended the Joint Advanced Warfighting School and then joined the Joint Enabling Capabilities Command's Joint Planning Support Element, where he conducted several deployments in support of defense planning efforts.
