  - Include your name, the names of any guests attending with you, and everyone's choice for the main course. If you don't specify a main course, the default "choice" is Roast Turkey Breast.
  - Any cancellations are required by **noon Friday, 18 April 2025**
  
- BASE ACCESS PROCEDURES:
  - People with an active duty, DoD CAC, retired military or dependent ID card will be admitted at an MCRD gates.
  - People without one of the above forms of ID must have their name on an access list that NSLPACSW must provide to MCRD Security ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE of the luncheon. When you make your reservation, please identify anyone in this category so their name gets on the access list no later than **noon Friday, 18 April 2025**. If a person's name is on that list, they only need to show your Driver's License at an MCRD gate.
  - MCRD Gate 2 on Barnett Street is the closest gate to the Bayview Restaurant.

Gates 2, 4 & 5 will be open for the event. Gate 2 is closest to the Bayview Restaurant.
